



How are my fees calculated? What is the number of weeks that I actually pay for? We take the 52 weeks that are in a year and then deduct 7 weeks from this to give us a 'working' total of 45 weeks. Why do you use 45 weeks? This is to allow for 2 weeks Summer Holiday and 2 weeks Christmas Holiday, as well as deducting the Bank Holidays, plus an additional allowance of 'unforeseen days' e.g. if a venue is unavailable, such as being used as a polling station. As you can see, we do allow quite a generous amount of 'unforeseen days' to ensure that you are not being charged should classes not run for any reason. However, if you wish to train when your particular venue is closed, you are welcome to attend an alternative class at any of our other venues for the duration of the closure. This applies to all of our classes. If you are attending an alternative venue for this reason, you are able to do so at no additional cost.

Does that mean you still use 12 months for a year? Yes, we still work on 12 months in a year but we've allowed for those days shown above within this. So that means that within each month we have automatically deducted the appropriate number of "no classes" – you're not paying for those! When do I need to pay? All fees MUST be paid via direct debit. The fees are, as mentioned, monthly and of course they are on an interest free basis.

What notice do I have to give? If you need to give notice that your child/you will be leaving COTKD we need one full payable months notice so for example, if you decide in mid January that you want to leave, we would require notice of a month – meaning that we would need to take the February payment – and you would leave us in March.

Ok, so what do I need to pay? we have the following fees which are per person per month

The fee is £24 per month if your child trains with us once a week $£24 \times 12 \text{ months} = £288$ (this works out at a little over £6 per class based on 45 weeks)

The fee is £34 per month if your child trains with us twice a week $£34 \times 12 \text{ months} = £408$ (this works out at a discounted rate of just £9 per week based on 45 weeks)

What if I've got one more than TWO family member training? If you have more than two members of your immediate family training – then we have some special discounts you can take advantage. Every third member and above will get a 50% discount. For example three members training once a week would cost a total of £60.
